

TedsWoodworking 16,000 Woodworking Plans

What's inside, who it suits, and what \$67 actually buys



This guide summarises what is published on the product's own website: the plan library, the members area, the four bonuses, the one-time price and the refund terms. Nothing here is written from memory, and nothing here is a promise of results.

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The library, the members area and lifetime access
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The short version

TedsWoodworking is a one-time \$67 purchase for lifetime access to a library the vendor states holds more than 16,000 project plans, each with cut lists, materials lists and dimensioned drawings. The vendor's standard membership price is \$39/month, so the offer is priced as a replacement for that subscription. There is a 60-day money-back guarantee, handled by the merchant through ClickBank.

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The problem with most plans



Where most downloaded plans fail: halfway through the build.

A plan looks fine on screen. You buy the lumber, start cutting, and three steps in the numbers stop agreeing with each other. A dimension is missing. The materials list is short by two boards. The assembly order skips the one step you actually needed.

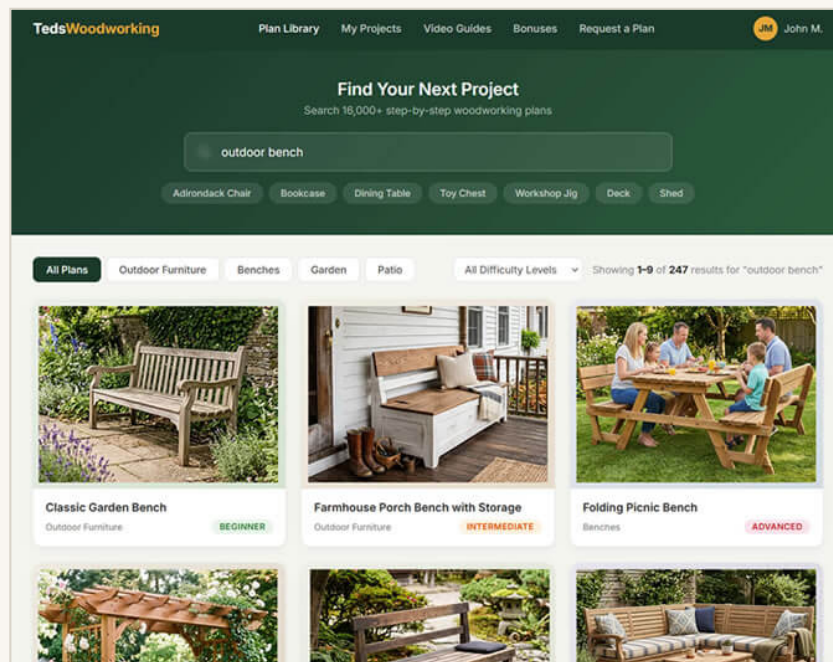
That is the failure mode almost every free plan and cheap plan pack shares: it was drawn, but never built. Nobody put a saw to it before publishing. The cost is not the plan — it is the wasted lumber, the second trip to the store and the weekend you do not get back.

What the vendor says it does differently

Every plan is drafted, physically built and shop-tested before publication, so measurements, cut lists, hardware specs and assembly order are verified before the plan reaches a member.

What you get for \$67

- ✓ Instant access to all 16,000 projects with step-by-step details, drawings, plans, cutting and materials lists (\$297 value)
- ✓ Lifetime membership access — a searchable, filterable members area with categories and difficulty levels
- ✓ Lifetime free monthly plans — new plans every month with no recurring fees (\$39 per month value)
- ✓ Free custom plan request — a plan drafted for your specific project by the vendor's craftsmen (\$250 value)
- ✓ 100% risk-free money-back guarantee for 60 days

Delivery

Access is an instant digital download plus the lifetime members area. A physical USB drive or DVD set can be shipped worldwide for a small additional fee at checkout.

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How it works

01 Search the library

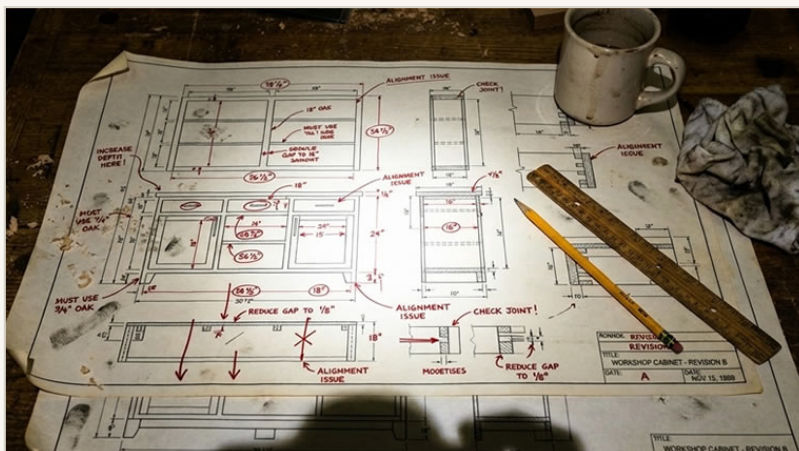
Type what you want to build. The members area returns matching plans with difficulty and material requirements shown up front.

02 Print the cut list

Each plan opens with a materials list and cutting list. Take it to the lumber yard and buy exactly what the project needs — once.

03 Follow the tested build order

Steps are sequenced the way the plan was physically built, with dimensioned drawings for each stage, including the joinery detail free plans skip.



Plans are built before they are published.

Free plans vs the library

The difference is not the drawing. It is whether anyone built the thing before publishing the plan — which is what determines whether your cut list is right the first time.

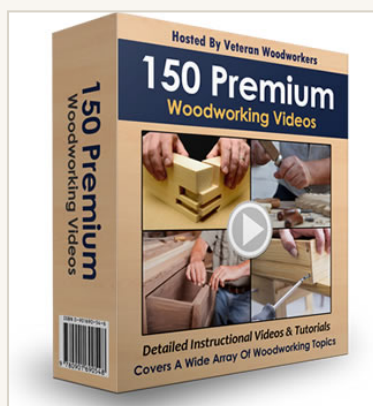

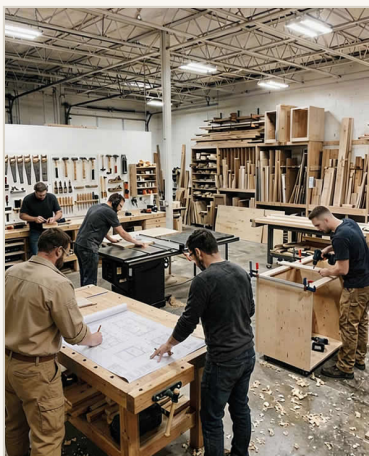
Who it suits

A good fit if

- ✓ You want plans that work the first time, on weekends you can't repeat
- ✓ You are a beginner who needs difficulty labels and full measurements
- ✓ You build outdoor furniture, sheds, coops or garage storage
- ✓ You want to sell finished pieces locally

Skip it if

- You want a video course rather than printable plans
- You need CNC-ready production files for commercial manufacturing
- You are not willing to read a cut list before cutting



The vendor states it employs a team of twelve full-time plan designers.

Those figures — twelve designers, five new plans a week, 54,183 satisfied customers — are the vendor's own published numbers, quoted here as vendor claims rather than as our findings.
